

# Student Right-to-Know Disclosure



Pursuant to the Higher Education Opportunity Act (HEOA) of 2008, colleges and universities must make available to current and prospective students information about student body diversity, including the percentage of enrolled full-time students who are male, female, self-identified members of a major racial or ethnic group, and those who receive a Federal Pell Grant during September 1, 2014 – August 31, 2015. The information is as follows:

The graduation rate cohort consists of full-time, first-time (FTFT) degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students and tracks their completion status at 150% of the normal time to complete their program.
